As explained in Treatment Proposal Plan Steven is an extremely disturbed, withdrawn little boy. Steven came into care with many emotional needs and problems. He is very fearful and finds it almost impossible to trust and therefore engage in any relationships. It will take a very committed and patient caretaker to meet this boy's needs.

In the past month this worker and his Youth worker have noticed that Steven has regressed and a concerted effort on the part of myself, the caretakers and his Youth worker will be required address Steven's increasingly withdrawn behavior.

This behavior that Steven is displaying is a result of a number of issues. My suspect at this time that Steven has been victimized by his sister [REDACTED] constantly, both physically and possibly sexually. Steven is unable at this time to talk about any issue relating to Sheila except on the most superficial level.
