They also have a good school in the area and mom was contacting relatives who would be helpful to this move for [REDACTED]. Spoke about a witnessed letter of agreement outlining the terms and duration of this arrangement, any financial considerations to be given to the dad; and some prior agreed upon process should the inter-family arrangement break down. This might be put into effect next month for a two week trial basis. This worker indicated that he would recommend closing this case at this point; but that she could call should she like some informal support or suggestions.
